QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Students must be a current student of a WMTA teacher.
2. Students must be in the 12th grade.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. A completed student application.
2. A student essay of 500 words, postmarked by October 1, 2017, to Jacqueline Banks at 1810 16th Street NW, 3rd Floor, Washington DC 20009. Application and essay may be emailed as a PDF to JacquelineBanks@NationalConservatoryOfArts.org, by 11:59 pm on October 1, 2017.
3. A signed and completed Publishing Release Form.
4. A short bio and photograph of the student.

The committee shall select the awardee by October 15, 2017.
